When Participating in Mobility Activities -

Before Mobility

- Publish and regularly update the course catalogue on the website of the institution well in advance of the choices about the courses they will tollow mobility periods, so as to be transparent to all parties and allow mobile students to make well-informed
- * Carry out mobility only within the framework of prior agreements between institutions. These agreements shared quality criteria in the selection, preparation, reception and integration of mobile participants establish the respective roles and responsibilities of the different parties, as well as their commitment to
- Ensure that outgoing mobile participants are well prepared for the mobility, including having attained the necessary level of linguistic proficiency
- Ensure that student and staff mobility for education or training purposes is based on a learning agreement or enterprises and the mobile participants for students and a mobility agreement for staff validated in advance between the home and host institutions
- Provide assistance related to obtaining visas, when required, for incoming and outgoing mobile participants
- Provide assistance related to obtaining insurance, when required, for incoming and outgoing mobile participants
- Provide quidance to incoming mobile participants in finding accommodation.

During Mobility

- Ensure equal academic treatment and services for home students and staff and incoming mobile participants
- Integrate incoming mobile participants into the institution's everyday life.
- Have in place appropriate menturing and support arrangements for mobile participants
- Provide appropriate Inquistic support to incoming mobile participants

- Accept all activities indicated in the learning agreement as counting towards the degree, provided these have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile students
- + Provide incoming mobile partropants and their home institutions with transcripts containing a full, accurate and timely record of their achievements at the end of their mobility period.

Support the reintegration of mobile participants and give them the opportunity, upon return, to build on their

- ullet Ensure that staff are given recognition for their teaching and training activities undertaken during the mobility experiences for the benefit of the institution and their peers period, based on a mobility agreement
- When Participating in European and International Cooperation Projects
- Ensure that cooperation leads to sustainable and balanced outcomes for all partners
- Provide relevant support to staff and students participating in these activities.
- \star Exploit the results of the projects in a way that will maximise their impact on individuals and participating sistitutions and entburage peer learning with the wider academist community
